The Division of International Affairs at SUU was created in January of 2015 and resides organizationally within the Office of the Provost. Under the leadership of Dr. Stephen Allen, Associate Provost for International Affairs, the Division is comprised of several departments, staff, and services which include:

International Recruitment

Recruits globally diverse and talented students from around the world.

American Language and Culture Center (ALCC)

Provides language and culture support to students and community members for whom English is a second language.

International Student and Scholar Services

Facilitates a wide array of support services designed to promote the academic and social success of international students and scholars.

Learning Abroad

Coordinates SUU's study abroad and exchange programs as well as students' Global EDGE projects.

Short Term Programs and Homestay

Provides global connections that allow students to experience the U.S. in a more immersive, personal way.

Confucius Institute

Promotes Chinese language and culture on campus and in the region.

Did You Know...

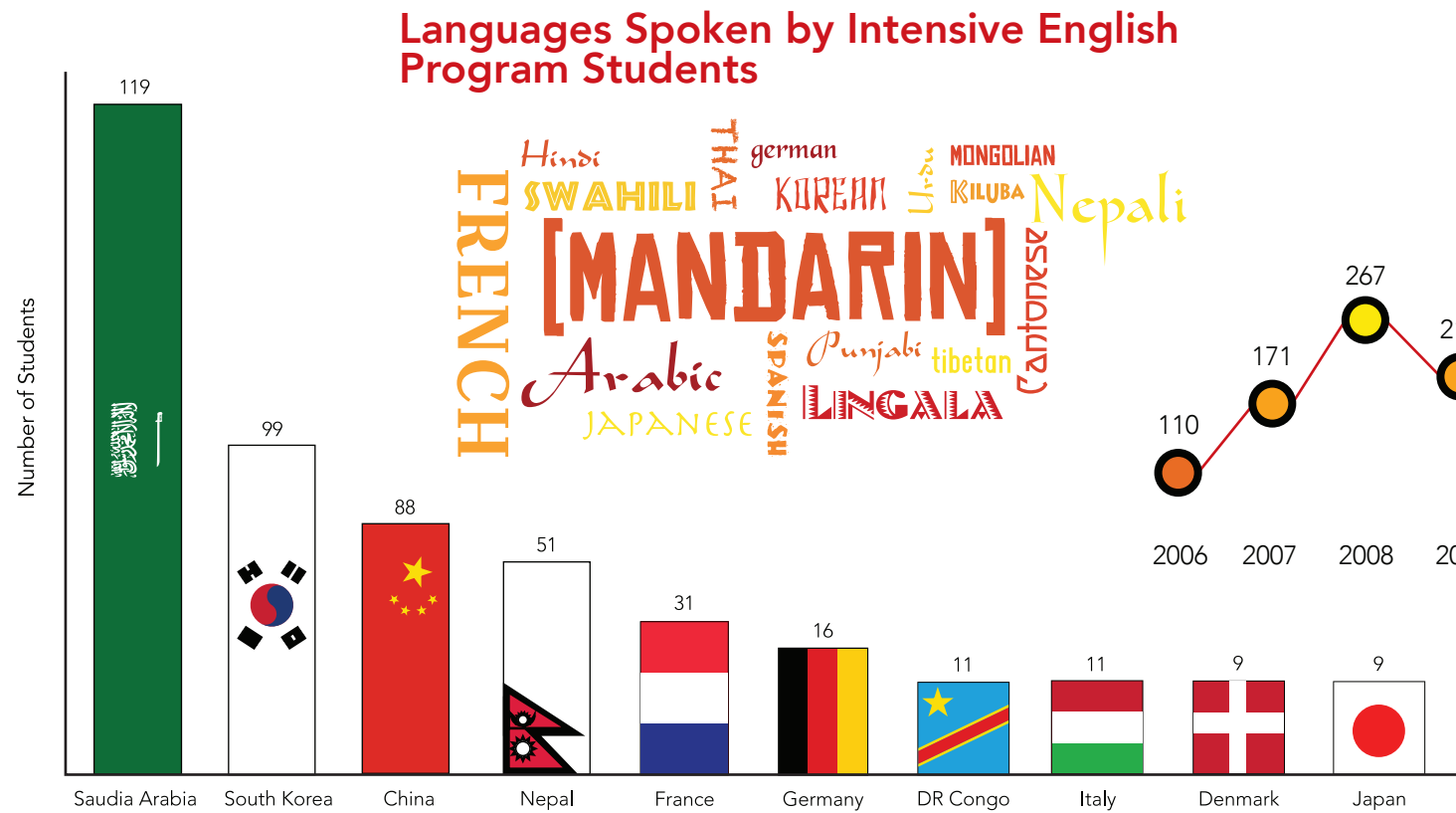
- **International Recruitment** has a team of recruiters with strategic focus on regions of the world where stronger representation is desired in order to diversify our international student population on campus.
- The **ALCC** includes an Intensive English Program, Pathway Program, Workshop Classes, and a Community ESL Program, which is supported by Zions Bank. The ALCC's Intensive English program has an innovative curriculum that includes both task-based and project-based learning.
- **International Student and Scholar Services** has hosted or will host over 87 events, services and excursions in the 2016-2017 school year designed for international students to connect and engage with domestic and other international students.
- **Learning Abroad** helped T-birds engage in significant learning experiences in over 25 countries in 2015-2016.
- **Short Term Programs** bring international groups to the SUU campus to experience specialized workshops, classes, and activities. Participants learn teamwork, academic skills, leadership and intercultural competency. Staying with homestay host families, participants experience culture, traditions, and even favorite American meals.
- The **Confucius Institute** at SUU is 1 of approximately 100 to be awarded to schools in the US to promote Chinese language and culture.

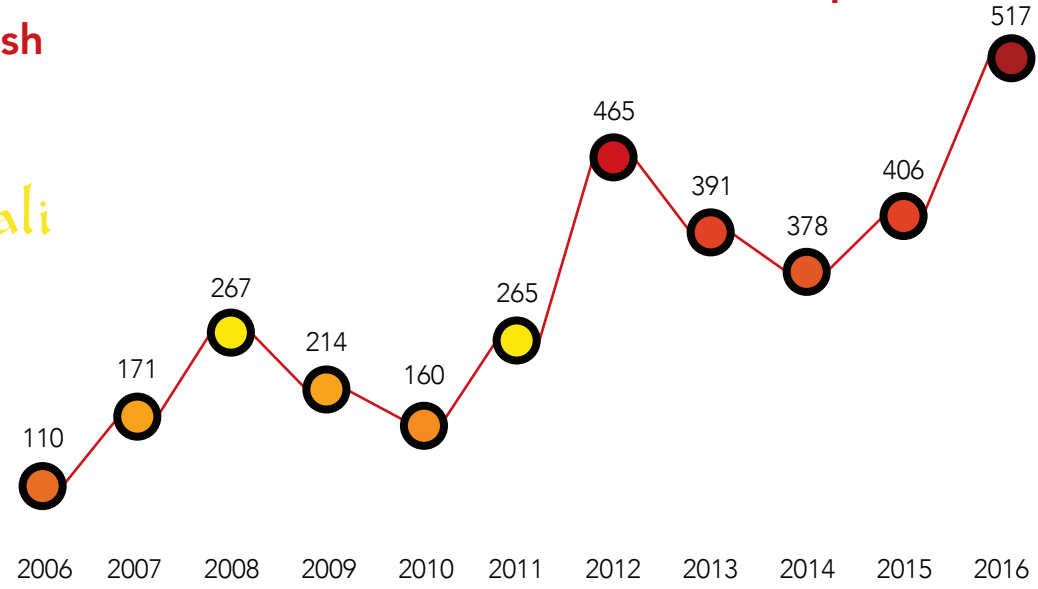
Top 10 countries



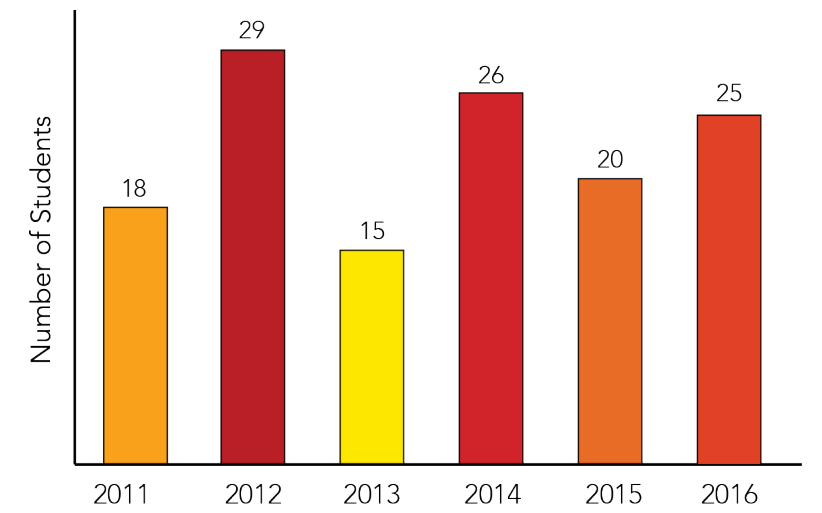
Languages Spoken by Intensive English Program Students



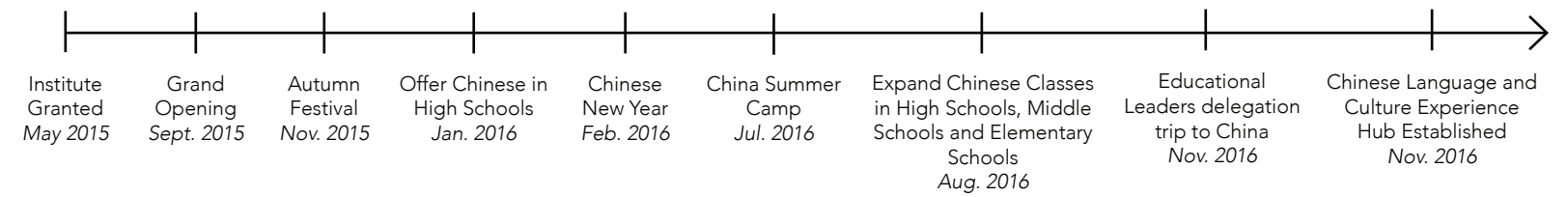
International Enrollment 10 Year Comparison

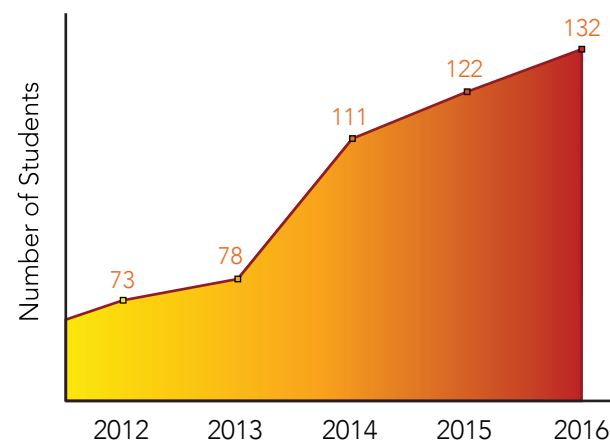
