Students seeking elected or appointed offices in the Student Involvement and Leadership Office must be willing to fulfill the following requirements. Please initial next to each number after you've read each section to acknowledge you've read the section and commit to the following requirements:

___ (1) Must meet the eligibility requirements laid out in the Student Programming Board Constitution:

SECTION 2: In order to be eligible to run for SPB President or apply for any appointed position an individual shall:

- A. Be matriculated as a student at SUU;
- B. Be enrolled in and complete at all times a minimum of twelve [12] semester hours as an Undergraduate student or nine [9] semester hours as graduate student;
- C. Possess a minimum cumulative GPA of a 3.0 for SPB President on a 4.0 scale to apply for and/or run for an elected or appointed position. During the academic year he/she is in office will have to maintain a 3.0 minimum semester GPA.
- D. Must be in good standing with University Conduct.

___ (2) Must meet Candidate Eligibility Requirements laid out below:

- A. A student must meet the requirements for office as outlined above to be considered for candidacy.
- B. Candidates must read all Election Bylaws and the SPB Constitution prior to running.

___ (3) SPB President candidates cannot be affiliated in any way or run with any SUUSA candidate/party and must run independently. SPB candidates can only seek and/or provide a verbal endorsement from any of the SUUSA candidates/parties running.

___ (4) A student who is elected or appointed to office may not hold another leadership position on campus or may not participate in other leadership activities that prevent them from attending retreats, regularly scheduled meetings, and SPB events and activities.

___ (5) Attend Inauguration April 20 at 6:00 pm, Utah Leadership Academy May 15-18, and SPB Retreats in April (1 day) May/June (3 days), and August (3 days)

___ (6) The Student Programming Board President must be residing in Cedar City during the summer (May-August)

___ (7) Must attend STIL Leadership Speaker series twice a semester and any other required trainings during the academic year

___ (8) Must meet with the Staff Advisor and the person currently in the position they are running for (unless that person is running for the same position) before the Candidacy Declaration Form Due Date.

I have read the Candidacy Declaration Form, SPB Constitution, and Election Bylaws and agree to abide by the rules and provisions stated in those documents. I also give my permission to the Office of Student Involvement and Leadership to review my academic and conduct record for the purpose of confirming my eligibility.
